



Specialist AV Testing Awarded to Enex TestLab

Enex TestLab's, the world's premier independent testing laboratory, has been awarded "*specialist anti-virus testing*" status by the UK's CESG (information assurance branch of Government Communications Head Quarters (GCHQ)).

The accreditation was given to Enex TestLab because of its work to develop a new CCTM method for testing. The lab has established new testing processes which use live malware, captured continuously in its global honey pot network. This live malware is used to test anti-virus solutions in a real-time, real-world environment – a significant improvement over the dated, library-based approaches.

The award comes as part of Enex TestLab's ongoing involvement with the CCT Mark Scheme (CESG Claims Testing Mark Scheme). For over two years, Enex TestLab has been delivering claims testing services to CESG for a wide range of products.

The achievement of *specialist anti-virus testing* status recognises the high level of professionalism and innovation that that Enex TestLab brings to ICT testing.
